








Foyful and Challenging Learning Our learning helps to bring nien!



Early Reading

We made a collage, cutting and clipping from magazines and newspapers, to find sight words we have learned.

Phonemic Awareness: we are learning syllable deletion.

Gravity keeps us standing. There is no upside-down right-side-up in the world!














If you see something...
